



## ADVANCED SUBJECT CONTROL INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION

This course is the third in a series of **Non-Impact Oriented, Outcome Based, and Video Camera Safe** subject control programs. Officers will be taken beyond the "learn this technique, teach this technique" concept of defensive tactics which is what has perpetually kept officers 5 years behind the street fighter in knowledge and ability.

*No matter how many training hours are spent trying to fit a square peg into a triangle hole it will not change the realities of the situation.....If something does not work drop it and find something that does.*

Only A.L.E.A. teaches officers how to evaluate any Defensive Tactics programs being taught today for need, training viability, practicality, resistance scenario training and finally, utilization in REAL world dynamic fights where things that can go wrong usually do. Students will develop a complete understanding of the body mechanics involved in aggression which will allow them to have the proper skill sets to work out any subject control problems with any officer regardless of size or strength.

Armed with this in-depth knowledge of fighting officers will be able to sift through the endless waves of Defensive Tactics techniques available to them in the market place and pick and choose what will actually work and discard those that do not. Officers will return to their departments being able to analyze their departmental policy and design, articulate and implement a Subject Control training program that will meet the specific needs of their department instead of blindly following a generic boxed program.

All Subject Control Programs are Tactically, Legally and Medically approved and certified by MCOLES and 302 approved. By de-emphasizing the need for striking the A.L.E.A. programs can **reduce departmental and officer liability** over traditional outdated impact-oriented defensive tactics. With that said impact principles and techniques will be covered showing the pros and cons of impact at various points in an aggressive confrontation. Officers will be shown how to maximize impact efforts should the need arise to escalate to striking.

This 3-day **ADVANCED** instructor course is a stand alone course teaching specific concepts but it also builds on previous concepts learned in the Basic and Intermediate courses making it a complete unified system.

Officers will learn the A.L.E.A. concepts of:

- **Universal Protection.**
- **Sudden Violent Attacks** in confined spaces (i.e. Car, Bus, Plane, Train).
- The mechanics of **Close Quarter Striking.**
- **Close Quarter Handcuffing** and follow up to aggression.
- The **Mechanics of Take Downs** (Front and Rear).
- The **Folding Knife Fighting and Defense** course.
- **Weapon Retention** (Standing and Grounded).
- **Weapon Recovery**
- Handling **Multiple Attackers**
- The **Expandable Baton** program (includes grappling with a baton).
- **Vehicle Extraction**

Like all of our courses, each concept deals with clearing and escalating or engaging and finishing an aggressive subject. All together our program meets and exceeds the M.C.O.L.E.S. "Subject Control Outcomes & Objectives" as laid out for all Michigan police academies.
