



## **INTERMEDIATE NON-IMPACT SUBJECT CONTROL INSTRUCTOR CERT.**

This course is second in a series of three, **Non-Impact Oriented, Outcome Based, and Video Camera Safe** subject control programs certified by MCOLES and 302 approved. By de-emphasizing the need for striking the A.L.E.A. programs can **reduce departmental and officer liability** over traditional outdated impact-oriented defensive tactics. With that said we also show how and where to strike in a fight to maximize efficiency.

This 3-day **INTERMEDIATE** instructor course is Tactically, Legally and Medically approved and will focus on the principles involved in successfully teaching officers how to escape from the basic controls of a trained grappler (*which is now taught on every street corner*) and either escape and escalate or close and control to handcuff. This course will have officers fighting in a 4' x 4' confined space yet will be shown how to successfully gain a position of advantage and regain control of a fight. Also covered will be Weapon Retention issues (standing and ground) and Weapon Recovery (standing, kneeling Execution with pistol & long gun).

Officers will learn easy concepts on how to control and manipulate an aggressive subject that builds on the Basic Instructor Course. Through proper movement and positioning an officer can reduce their vulnerability while gaining a position of advantage, regardless of size.

Together with the Basic and Advanced courses officers will be fully versed and confident in the Use-of-Force. Officers will be able to evaluate, design and articulate a customized defensive tactics program to suit their individual department needs instead of a generic boxed program. They will be taught how to handle aggression regardless of location or confined space (i.e. Car, Bus, Plane, Train).
